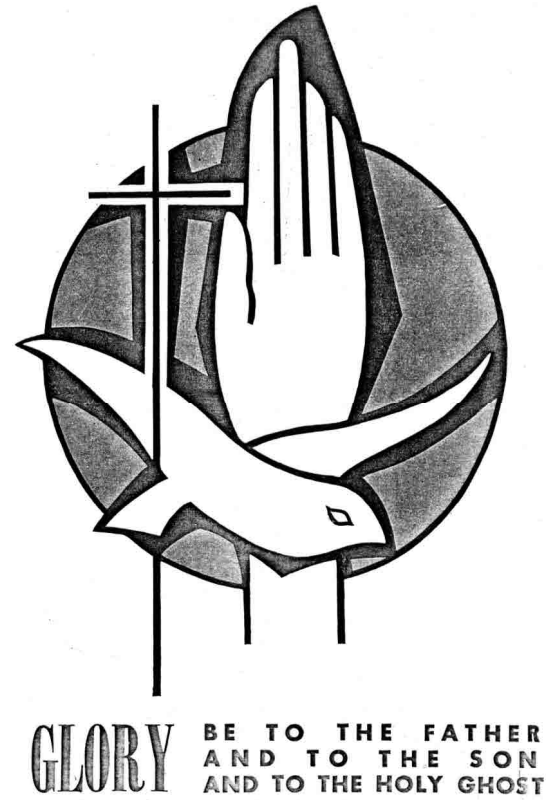

NEW FOUR ACRE SITE

The future location of Hihland's new Gloria Dei Lutheran Church has been designated by a sign erected at the corner of Orchard Street and Ridge Road, Highland on a four acre plot of ground.

Under the direction of Rev. Harold E. Koch, the congregation is presently engaged in its first annual building fund drive to raise funds for construction of an initial unit.

Gloria Dei is one of 120 new congregations that will receive guidance from the Board of American missions of the United Lutheran Church in America, this year in construction of permanent first units.

Presently the congregation worships in the all-purpose room of the Highland Christian School.

The congregation's office and pastor's study are located in the parsonage at 5415 Lincoln Street, Highland.
